REGISTRATION FEES

The fee for all four CPA review courses together is **\$1,995 (before any discounts)**. On an individual basis, the following fees apply: AUDITING \$495, BUSINESS ENVIRONMENT \$495, REGULATION \$595, FINANCIAL ACCOUNTING \$695. **Registering for all four courses together results in a substantial \$360 savings over individual prices (\$2,280 total).**

REFUNDS

A refund of fees, less an administrative charge of \$100 per part will be made if a cancellation for any or all parts of the USF CPA Review Program is received within five days before the beginning of that part. A full refund of fees is made for withdrawals more than five days in advance. There is normally no refund once a course has started.

REPEAT PRIVILEGE

Participants in USF's CPA Review Program should expect to do well on all parts of the CPA Examination if they attend all classes and complete the assigned readings and homework. However, a "repeat privilege" gives participants the opportunity to repeat any portion of the program, the next time it is offered, in which they need additional review for an administrative fee of only \$175 per part (includes text, but not software) or \$245 (includes text and software, if needed).
